


What is the Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP)?

- The Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) is a statewide electronic database.
- It tracks controlled substance prescriptions, including medical cannabis purchases.
- The Prescription Monitoring Program is managed by the Mississippi Board of Pharmacy.

Purpose

Prevent misuse, ensure patient safety, and assist healthcare decisions.




Practitioners

- Practitioners are required to review patient prescription history in the PMP prior to issuing a medical cannabis certification.
- The PMP is an essential tool in identifying potential misuse or diversion of controlled substances, including medical cannabis.

Dispensaries

- Dispensaries must report all medical cannabis sales to the PMP within 24 hours.
