Patient Application Guide

Steps to Becoming a Patient

1. Visit a licensed certifying practitioner

Only Practitioners licensed under the MMCP are allowed to certify patient for medical cannabis use. To see a list of licensed medical cannabis certifiers, please visit www.3MAms.org under “Patient Care”. A Bona-Fide Practitioner/Patient Relationship is required for certification.

2. Register online with the MSDH

3. Understanding the rules of the MMCP

Medical Records

Patients Seeking an MMCP Patient Card will need to provide their qualifying practitioner with records indicating they suffer from one of the qualifying medical conditions. [See the MSDH's List of Qualifying Medical Conditions.](#)



MSDH Portal Account

Note - Patients may register for an account and begin the application process BEFORE they obtain the required practitioner consultations.



Credit/Debit Card

In addition to the cost of the practitioner consultation, patients must also pay an annual license application processing fee (\$25) to the MS Department of Health in order to finalize their application. Payments must be made via debit/credit card.
